

# County Demo leader to see Jimmy Carter

Brazoria County Democratic Party leader and labor leader O.D. Kenemore will be one of a group of Texans chosen to meet with President Carter Tuesday to discuss the state of the nation.

Kenemore said he received a call Wednesday to attend a briefing session at the White House.

The Texans will meet with Carter and members of his staff, Kenemore said, to talk about what is happening in the country. "There's also a question-and-answer session — from both sides — that's been promised," he said.

Kenemore said he believes he was chosen for the briefing group more for his activities in the party than for his labor connections.

Others to attend include Houston Mayor Jim McConn, two Texas members of the National Democratic Committee and several other state party leaders, Kenemore said.

The group will arrive at the White House about 9 a.m., Kenemore said, and are scheduled to have lunch with the President and staff later in the day.
