# Kenemore Nominated For Service Award

O. D. Kennemore of Lake Jackson has been nominated by the Brazoria County United Way board as a candidate for next year's Joseph A. Bierne Community Service Award.

The award has been presented annually since 1974 by United Way of America to recognize labor leaders who have provided outstanding volunteer community service.

In making the nomination, local UW board member Duke Fuqua cited Kenemore's "extraordinary ser-

vice to the community." Letters supporting the nomination have been submitted by Sen. Lloyd Bentsen and Harry Hubbard, president of the Texas AFL-CIO.

Kenemore served as secretary and treasurer of the UW board from 1980-1982 and has been involved with the government relations, policy review, and planning committees. An active volunteer for two UW member agencies, he is a founder and current board member of the Brazoria County Youth Homes and a board member of the Visiting Nurses Association

of Brazoria County.

A charter member and business manager of the Pipefitters Local No. 390, he has served as the only president of the Freeport Metal Trades Council since 1967. He also has been president of the Tidelands Central Labor Council since 1975.

Kenemore has served as vice president and trustee of the Texas AFL-CIO for two years, and since 1970 has been vice president of the Texas State Pipe Trades.

He is a member of the Masonic Lodge, Brazoria County Shrine Club, and El

Mina Temple. He also is a precinct chairman of the Brazoria County Democratic Party.

Current chairman of the Dislocated Worker's Committee, he is past chairman of the Manpower Advisory Committee. Kenemore worked for Dow until 1973 when he resigned to work full time for the Pipefitters Union. He is a veteran of World War II. He also is active in the First Baptist Church of Clute.

Kennemore and his wife, Janice, have five children.
